Listos California has reached millions of highly vulnerable Californians in the last two years.

The ideal candidate will provide expertise and guidance to develop culturally appropriate, data-driven communications with an eye towards leveraging participation from diverse partners and trusted messengers to ensure that every Californian, regardless of age, ability, income or language, has the information they need to be prepared for the next disaster. The candidate will serve as a liaison between government and community, building ties to strengthen partnerships to ensure fruitful collaboration. Finally, the ideal candidate will work closely with community-based organizations to develop materials, trainings and media outreach strategies to be implemented by local partners.

This candidate will be a key member of Cal OES's Office of Crisis Communication and Public Affairs which is a dynamic and fast-paced organization with a problem-solving mentality.
